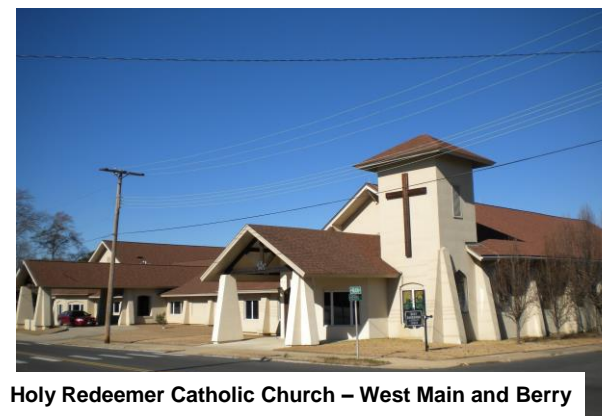

From the Pastor's Office...

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I frequently have lunch with some separated brethren, including local pastors. Recently, in passing, the Methodist minister made mention of the people coming to receive at the communion rail at his church. I thought to myself "wow, they still receive like we used to and they don't even believe nearly what we do about communion!"

This first Sunday of June we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi and for your consideration I have included an article from LifeSiteNews.com reporting on Cardinal Robert Sarah (the Prefect of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments - the man in charge of the Mass for the Church).

The article has a challenging title and I want to make it very clear from the outset that Cd. Sarah nor I am saying that anyone who receives Holy Communion in the hand is doing something Satanic. It is permissible in the U.S. but be aware that it is not in other countries, including the Vatican City (Communion on the tongue is the norm for the Church).

The article is reporting on a book that looks at how Communion in the hand got started and its effect. My intention is for his words and position in the Church to speak on their own.

There is a phrase in Latin "Lex orandi, lex credendi" which means the law of praying is the law of believing. The way we pray influences the way we believe.

I, as a pastor, and certainly Cd. Sarah, as the person in charge of Divine Worship, see a great change in how we treat with reverence, love, devotion and adoration the Blessed Sacrament in many places where Communion in the hand is prevalent. It is almost as if we wait are waiting in a line for a hot dog rather than gathered at the table to receive from our mama.

The Church is our Mother and She wants to feed us as children. St. John Paul II and St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta practiced this law of prayer and it bolstered their belief.

The Church feeds us as little babies incapable of feeding ourselves because she gives us the very Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of her Spouse Jesus Christ. It can never be taken. It must always be received.

The Church feeds us as sick, dying people incapable of feeding ourselves because we will die without the life of Christ, the Bread of Life.

The Church feeds us as bride receiving a piece of cake from her spouse because we receive from Jesus, the Church's Spouse, at His wedding feast.

PARISH NEWS...

From the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB):

Celiac disease is an immune reaction to eating gluten, a protein found in wheat, barley, and rye. For those with the disease, eating gluten triggers an immune response in the small intestine. Over time, this immune reaction damages the small intestine's lining and hinders absorption of some nutrients. The intestinal damage often causes stomach pain, diarrhea, and weight loss, and can lead to serious complications. A Mayo Clinic-led analysis published in 2012 estimates that roughly 1.8 million Americans have the disease, but around 1.4 million of them are unaware that they have it.

Given the serious health risk for those suffering gluten intolerance, it is important for pastors and other Church leaders not only to be aware of the reality, but prepared to address the situation of Catholics with celiac disease who come to parishes and seek to receive Holy Communion in a safe, sensitive, and compassionate manner.

The Risk of "Cross-Contamination"

For those members of the faithful with gluten intolerance, even trace amounts of gluten can be damaging. It is important, therefore, to be mindful of "cross-contamination" when using either low-gluten hosts or when offering Holy Communion to someone only under the species of wine... It might be necessary for someone who has permission to receive Holy Communion under the species of wine alone to prepare before Mass a chalice, which will not be part of the commingling rite and from which either they alone will receive or from which they will be the first to receive. Such precautions are not only medically necessary, but they demonstrate compassion to avoid singling out those who want to receive Communion, but are unable to receive one or the other species.


