

Catechist- coming from the Greek root “to echo” being a catechist means you echo the faith of the Church, as we have received it, back to our students in all its fullness. If you are a Confirmed Catholic, have a good knowledge of the faith and have a heart for ministry to young people, this is perfect for you. But even if you feel unqualified, many catechists say that being a catechist has actually helped them grow in the Faith! As Pope St. John II (quoting Jesus) would always say, “BE NOT AFRAID!”

Substitute- For the times the catechists are unable to teach, usually on short notice, you would come in and lead the lesson. We are always in need of more substitutes! If you are thinking about being a catechist but want a test run to try it out first, this is a great way to do that.
